



Colossians 1:27-29

“To whom God would make known what is the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles; which is Christ in you, the hope of glory: (28) Whom we preach, warning every man, and teaching every man in all wisdom; that we may present every man perfect in Christ Jesus: (29) Whereunto I also labour, striving according to his working, which worketh in me mightily.”

* Please pray each day through the General Prayer Points indicated by the (*) then **read in your Bible** and meditate on the scripture passage.

I Peter 2:9 *“But ye are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an holy nation, a peculiar people; that ye should shew forth the praises of him who hath called you out of darkness into his marvellous light”.*

***Pray for the Holy Spirit to anoint the weekly Corporate prayer calls and that members would call in. (Mondays, February 19 to March 26)**

* “Dear Lord, I Pray for the Holy Spirit to convict of sin the unsaved relatives and each person on my Prayer Care Share list. I pray that you will grant them grace to repent and believe in the Lord Jesus Christ. Use me Lord in their lives in practical ways.” (Read John 3:16 and 1 Timothy 2:3-4)

Day 1—“ Lord God, convict me and every COCHUSA member of any sin and give us grace to quickly repent and experience renewal and revival for your Glory.” Read Proverbs 28:13 and Psalm 51)

Day 2—I Pray we would be faithful and disciplined to read the Bible daily and ask the Holy Spirit to teach us Your Truth! (Read Psalms 1 and 42)

Day 3—I Pray that I/we would live to build intimate close fellowship with the Lord Jesus Christ. (Read Psalm 27)

Day 4—“I Pray that our praying would be Holy Spirit led”. (Read Matthew 6:5-18)

Day 5—I Pray we would grow in personal knowledge of God and live so that others might come to trust in Jesus for eternal life.. (2 Corinthians 2: 14 -15)

Day 6—I Pray we would have a strong hatred for sin and unrighteousness, and a strong love for holiness and justice. Pray for our Sunday School and HYM Nationwide (1 Peter 1:15 *“But just as He who called you is holy, so be holy in all you do;” (16) for it is written: “Be holy, because I am holy.”*)

Day 7—I Pray that we would have consistent daily personal devotional times. Pray for the Vision 2020 Task Force as they prepare and plan for our future. (Read Philippians 3:7-10)

Day 8—I Pray that our single men & women would live according to the Bible, for eternity and not just the “Here & Now.” (Read 1 Corinthians 7:32-35)

Day 9—I Pray that we would faithfully study, memorize and meditate on the Word of God daily with a heart committed to OBEY! (Read Psalm 1)

Day 10—I Pray that our young people would live pure lives in what they say, see, hear, feel and taste. (1 Timothy 4: 12 *Don't let anyone look down on you because*

you are young, but set an example for the believers in speech, in life, in love, in faith and in purity.) (Read also Titus 2:12-13)

Day 11—I Pray we reject and renounce the “god of materialism, greed, lust, pride and selfishness” in our lives. (Read 2 Peter 2:18-22)

Day 12—I Pray for the Board of Bishops to serve in humility, unity, holiness, faith and love; Please protect and provide for their families. (1 Timothy 2: 1 & 2)

Day 13—I Pray for my pastor, all of our pastors, District Chairmen & leaders, that they would be examples in holiness, humility, faith, and charity; that they would be willing to be held accountable, honorable and accurate teachers/preachers of the word of God. Pray for the NBM Read 1 Timothy 3:1-13)

Day 14—I Pray the Holy Spirit would control our music and we would not focus on entertaining people but rather worshipping YOU Lord. Prayer for the Budget Revision Task Force as they work to realign the National Budget. (Psalm 150 & 51)

Day 15—I Pray that members who work outside the home will be faithful servants of Jesus Christ—not compromising with language or behavior as they faithfully and ethically do their jobs unto the Lord. (Read Ephesians 5:1-20)

Day 16—I Pray that each member would generously share their financial resources, faithfully give their time and willingly offer their skills to advance the Gospel through the local church, in the neighborhoods and into other countries. (Read 2 Corinthians 8:7-8)

Day 17—Lord God, I pray you would do mighty and miraculous works of healing for your glory within the membership of COCHUSA and in the lives of those on our Prayer-Care-Share lists. (Read Matthew 9:18-33)

Day 18—I Pray for the moral, social and spiritual integrity of our deacons, trustees and other local church officers/leaders. (Read Colossians 1:10)

Day 19—I Pray for husbands and wives to be faithful to YOU and to each other, and that families would be healthy, practicing repentance and reconciliation. (Ephesians 5:25, Hebrews 13:4, Colossians 3:18-21)

Day 20—I Pray that all our pastors and leaders would boldly preach and teach morality and Christian ethics. Pray for our UCWM as they do ministry in our local churches. (Read Acts 4:29-31)

Day 21—I Pray that each of us would demonstrate compassionate love to the families in our communities and around our church properties who are facing difficult times financially, relationally, etc. Prayer for the Budget Revision Task Force as they work to realign the National Budget. (Read Matthew 11:28-30)

Day 22—I Pray that we would not be insensitive to the needs and the conditions of the poor and oppressed, and that we would minister to those in prison and those physically afflicted. Lord, make us people of justice. (Isaiah 1:17, Isaiah 58:10 and 1 John 3:17-18)

Day 23—"Dear God, extend mercy and gracious provision to those who need homes and jobs, in prison, in college and who are unwed or unborn." (Psalm 103:17)

Day 24—I Pray that the men and women who serve in our military would be aware of God's protection as they serve with honor and integrity. (Psalms 91:1-16)

Day 25—I Pray that our retired and elderly members would use their time, talents and treasures to engage or reengage in outreach and discipleship ministry-- "fight the good fight of faith"-- I Pray they would seek out ways to serve and support younger leaders. (Titus 2:1-5)

Day 26—I Pray for financial integrity in all our congregations! (Malachi 3:10)

Day 27—I Pray Lord for you to call more men to be pastors and for more members to be missionaries across the world. Pray for our National Missionaries as they assist in the work of the ministry in local churches. (Philippians 4:3)

Day 28—I Pray Lord you would show local congregations new ideas and ministry opportunities to spread the message of Christ in word and deed, especially through the National Church Health Initiative. Pray for the Vision 2020 Task Force as they prepare and plan for our future. (Acts 2:40-46)

Day 29—I Pray that each local Church along with each district and each diocese would faithfully pray, care and share to plant new churches. (Read Hebrews 10:23-25) (Read Acts 2:40-46)

Day 30—I Pray that our local churches would be wise and willing partners with other Bible Believing congregations for cooperative evangelism and discipleship. (Matthew 28:18-20)

Day 31—I Pray for a mighty work of God in and through the **HYM** & **YAM** that would result in widespread revival resulting in passionate worship and unyielding devotion in our young people. (Read 1 Timothy 4:12)

Day 32—I Pray that the men and boys of the **NBM** would become more devoted to knowing and serving Jesus Christ, more disciplined in their devotional lives and more dedicated to obeying the word of God and applying it to all areas of life. (Read Titus 2:2, 6-8)

Day 33—I Pray that the women and young ladies of the **UCWM** would follow

after modesty and sanctification. I Pray that they would work in harmony with all other ministries to advance God's Kingdom through witnessing and other outreach activities. (Read Titus 2:3-5)

Day 34—I Pray for a unifying and purifying work of God in and through each person who serves on and is served by the work and ministry of the Evangelism & Missions Board, Board of Pensions and Benefits. National Deacons Ministry, National Education & Trustee Board and National Publishing Board. (Read John 17)

Day 35— I Pray for a spirit of evangelism in our church, that we would pray for the salvation of those we have identified as needing Christ. (Matthew 28:18-20)

Day 36—I pray for those who serve in Government and Law enforcement, especially those who profess to know Jesus Christ, that they live/work like they know Him. (Read 1 Timothy 2:1-4)

Day 37— Pray that we would all engage in fruitful and practical community ministry. (Read Matthew 9:38 and Psalms 96)

Day 38— I that you would use National "**Back to Church Sunday**" outreach September 16, 2018, as a significant and fruitful PCS soul-winning effort. (Jude 22-23)

Day 39— I Pray for believers in other parts of the world to be protected from the spirit of dishonesty, material greed, conformity to the world's value system, demonic traditions, ethnic unrest and violence. (Read Romans 12:1-2)

Day 40— I pray that You lead us as a denomination into a season of great and lasting harvesting of souls to the glory of your great name! (John 15)

(1 Timothy 2:1-6) - "I urge, then, first of all, that requests, prayers, intercession and thanksgiving be made for everyone-- 2 for kings and all those in authority, that we may live peaceful and quiet lives in all godliness and holiness. 3 This is good, and

pleases God our Savior, 4 who wants all men to be saved and to come to a knowledge of the truth. 5 For there is one God and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus, 6 who gave himself as a ransom for all men--the testimony given in its proper time."
