## You Can Recover!

*“Then he went down, and dipped himself seven times in Jordan, according to the saying of the man of God: and his flesh came again like unto the flesh of a little child, and he was clean. “*

2 Kings 5:14

What does it mean to experience a ‘recovery’? One definition is “a return to a normal state of health, mind, or strength.” Or, it can be the restoration of lost things.” In this passage, we have a man who experienced an amazing recovery!

First, Naaman received a **reward** for his effort in doing as the man of God asked him. We may not always see or understand the why and what God is asking us to do, but there is a reward in our obedience.

Second, Naaman was **blessed** to receive a miracle of healing from what was known as an incurable disease. We may receive a miracle from God if we believe and be obedient to the voice of the Lord.

Third, Naaman experienced **growth through trial**. Trials that we go through are to help us grow in our relationship with God. Naaman was persuaded that there was a prophet in Israel. God does the unthinkable sometimes, just to reveal to someone that He is God.
